Gutters

Rain guttering that is old or inferior in design or construction quality can fail, leaving rain pouring over the edges and creating puddles or running water against the foundation of your home. Ice dams can form at faults in the gutters, which can cause pressure against the eaves of your roof and undermine its construction. Roof leaks may result, which can lead to damage to the roof decking, tie beams, insulation, wall studs, drywall, flooring, electrical wiring and outlets, lighting fixtures, and the interior contents of rooms. These serious problems can lead to broader damage that can weaken the structure of your house. These risks are avoidable by timely action to repair and maintain the gutters. Repairs

Maintenance

Periodic cleaning and maintenance of roof shingles, natural stone slate, wooden shakes, metal or rubber roofing, or other materials are important to preserve the life of a roof. Checking for loose or missing roofing nails, cracked or deteriorated adhesives, detached flashing, chimney covers, vent pipe caps, etc., is essential to preventing leaks that can saturate felt underlayment, plywood decking, and other construction components, electrical wiring, attic insulation, ceiling drywall, and interior living spaces below. Proper roof maintenance inspection and cleaning, especially in humid climate regions, can help prevent mold development, moss growth, and other issues that can discolor and otherwise damage the roof surface and diminish its protective benefits.

Skylights

Skylights can bring a wonderful flood of natural light into a home and create a special atmosphere in any living space. But, proper installation of skylights and flashing and routine inspection and maintenance of these rooftop window units are critical. Quality

installation and inspections help avoid leaks that can run from the skylight location under the roof even to distant locations of the house. Skylights and other rooftop components with the potential for forming leaks tend to cost *a little* more for quality installation and periodic inspection or cost *a lot* more in major home repairs due to neglect of proper attention through the years.

Insulation

In homes with insufficient roof insulation with a low R-value under the roof, there are often serious conditions of poor comfort levels in the living spaces, exposure of fire sprinkler plumbing lines in upper walls to extreme cold that can cause pipes to freeze, break, and leak water in the attic, or between the roof deck and the ceiling. Uninsulated and uncovered fixed-opening rooftop vents can cause extreme heating and cooling losses that drive up utility bills and compromise home comfort. Having the roof or attic abundantly insulated saves money and improves the quality of life in the house for homeowners who maximize their roof's energy efficiency with the proper installation of quality insulation.

Can new shingles be applied on top of existing shingles?

Yes. It is easy to install new shingles on top of your roof's existing shingles in most cases. ***This is most optimal when there's only one layer of flat-lying shingles on the roof and the roof deck is in good shape.***

Covering up existing shingles is a ***faster and cheaper alternative*** that doesn't affect your roof's appearance.

However, shingling over your roof is ***not always ideal***. By tearing off the roof, you'll identify other issues that may stay hidden if you only re-roof. Re-roofing is the ideal time to look at other roof components, such as vents, for example. It's also important to check with your municipality to make sure local building codes are followed when it comes to roof shingles.

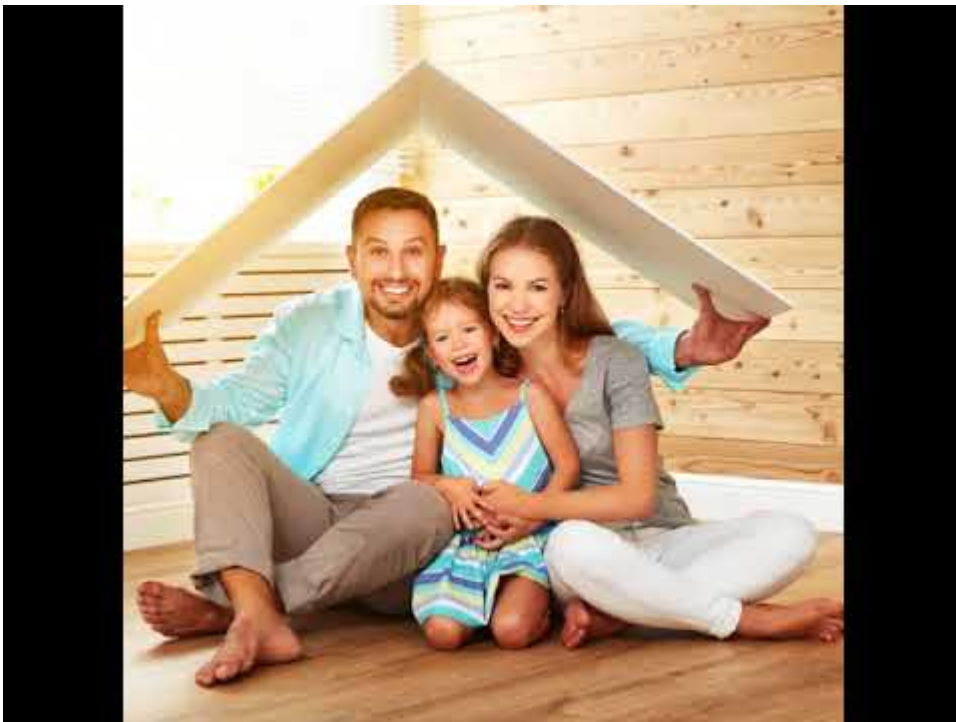
